


## **Leaves of the Tree trail trees**















weeping birch

**Chestnuts (Castinea sativa)** 

were planted in 1690! The old-

est tree in the grounds is the

Oak ( Quercus robur) adjacent

to the artificial pitch, at least

five hundred years old. We

have over six different varieties

of oak. Three varieties of

Beech, Eight varieties of Birch.

In total over ninety different varieties of trees.





23: Judas Tree (Cercis siliquastrum)


18: London Plane (Platanus x hispanica)
