We are now offering universal 3 and 4 year-old free early education for 15 hours per week. **Children are eligible for the universal entitlement the term after their 3rd birthday.**

The free 15 hours will be made up as follows:

- Monday to Friday 8.30am to 11.30am term time only. (Term times will be the usual Ruspini House dates as per the website).
- Our full morning sessions are 8.30am – 12.45pm including lunch. Costs for the term include consumables, additional hours and services. This can be paid for using childcare vouchers.
- Afternoon sessions must follow morning sessions and finish at 3.45pm.
- Invoices will be sent termly and are payable prior to the start of each term.

In order for us to claim within the terms and conditions of the Universal 3 and 4 year old scheme you will need to provide us with a parent declaration form. If this is not provided we will not be able to make a claim and full fees will apply.

Additional Information:

- Pre-School pupils must attend at least three morning sessions per week. The 15 hours free early education can be accessed for 3 hours per morning session.
- Nursery pupils must attend five mornings per week.
- Additional sessions should be pre booked a term in advance, cancellation of any of these sessions requires a term's written notice in advance. Ad-hoc sessions may be available and booked through My School Portal, we are unable to apply the government funding to ad hoc sessions.
- Prices include a midmorning snack, milk, a hot lunch and all specialist lessons for the applicable sessions.
- Childcare Voucher Schemes can be used to pay Nursery fees.
- Notice is required a term in advance otherwise a term's full fees will be liable (fees in lieu of notice).
- Please also be aware that to the extent that the school is unable to claim early years funding for attendance, fees due will be exclusive of funding.
